## Vacancy Election

*Fair Work (Registered Organisations) Act 2009*

Nominations are called for the following office:

- **Federal TAFE Secretary**

**Nominations**, which must be in writing and comply with the registered rules of the Organisation, may be made at any time from 08/03/2019. Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than** 05:00pm (AEDT) **on** 25/03/2019.

### Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 05:00pm (AEDT) on 01/04/2019. Such withdrawal must be by notice in writing to the Returning Officer signed by the nominee and submitted by hand, post or facsimile or any other electronic means.

Prospective candidates and nominators should verify their financial status and any other qualifications required by the rules of the Branch prior to lodging nominations.

### PLEASE NOTE:

1. Emails to the AEC inbox that appear to be spam may be blocked. It is the responsibility of senders to ensure that their email reaches the AEC before the deadline for nominations.
2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.

### Voting Period

The ballot, if required, will open on 12/04/2019 and close at 10:00am (AEST) on 10/05/2019.

### Scrutineers

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers. In accordance with Rule 39(12) each candidate appointing a scrutineer shall hand to the Returning Officer not less than one day prior to the close of the ballot a completed scrutineers appointment form.
